Dear Friend, thank you for your excellent questions. The date of Easter is determined by the first Sunday after the first full moon after the spring equinox. So the date of Easter may vary by a month or so from year to year. The date of Orthodox Easter (May 2 this year) differs from our own because we use the Gregorian calendar and the Orthodox Church uses the Julien calendar.
