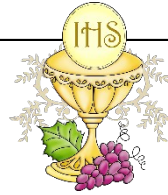
### From the Pastor's Desk

The Easter vigil candle will simply be placed in the middle aisle at the beginning of Mass with no procession. May the Lord bless you as we relive the last week of Jesus' earthly life and remember His sufferings for us.
