From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Father, I was wondering... Is it permissible for a Catholic to join the shriners?

Dear friend, thank you for your interesting question. According to their website, all shriners are masons. Catholics are not allowed to become shriners or masons under pain of excommunication. There was some confusion about this following the Second Vatican council, but the Church continues to forbid membership in the Masons because Masonic rules and rituals are irreconcilable with Catholic doctrine. We find that freemasonry is a religion in itself. It includes temples, altars, a moral code, worship services, vestments, feast days, a hierarchy of leadership, initiation, and burial rites. Several guilds of freemasons united in 1717 in London, England to form the grand lodge of freemasons. The rituals of the order are contrary to the Catholic faith. The two enemies of freemasonry are listed as the roaylty and the papacy. When one reaches the 30th degree in the heirarchy of Masons they crush the symbol of the pope's tiara and the royal crown. A former leader refered to the papacy as a "deadly, treacherous enemy." Since 1738 Catholics have been forbidden to join the Masons.
